

Form 486 Overview

- Form 486 has two purposes:
 - It informs the SLD that they are authorized to pay invoices (either BEAR or SPIFs), and
 - It informs the SLD that your school or library is CIPA compliant
- Can only be filed after the FCDL has been issued (after funding has been committed)
- BEAR and vendor (SPI) invoices cannot be paid until the Form 486 has been submitted
 - FY 2024 BEARs and SPIs can't be submitted until July 1, 2024
- Vendors will usually not discount bills until the Form 486 has been submitted/approved

Form 486 in EPC

- All Form 486s must be filed in EPC
 - No paper 486s will be accepted
- Form 486 Approval Letters are e-mailed to applicant
 - Letters also are available under Notifications on the EPC Landing Page
- Form 486 is streamlined
 - Form pre-populates FRNs and service start dates based on the approved 471(s)
 - Applicants will select relevant FRNs and will not enter any new data
 - Certifications will change based on applicant type (school, library or consortium)
 - Form is brief and quick to complete
- Vendors will receive 486 Approval Notification in their vendor portals

Deadline for Filing Form 486

- 120 days after FCDL date or Service Start Date listed on Form 486, whichever is later
 - For recurring services FRNs (Category 1 and Basic Maintenance of C2), the earliest deadline is October 28
- Penalty for late Form 486 filing:
 - USAC adjusts the Service Start Date to 120 days from the Form 486 filing date
 - Essentially this means USAC will deduct 1 months' worth of funding for each 30 days that the 486 is submitted late
 - If the deadline is missed, USAC will issue a '486 Urgent Reminder Notice' in EPC Newsfeed
 - Applicants then have 15 additional calendar days to submit the 486 without penalty

Consortium Leads - Must Collect Form 479s Annually

- In order for consortia applicants to submit the Form 486, they are required to <u>annually</u> collect signed Form 479s from their consortia members
 - The consortia applicant can then submit the Form 486 and certify that they have collected the 479s and that no consortia member is seeking a CIPA waiver
- Form 479 is a paper form
 - Not online or in EPC
 - Available at: https://www.usac.org/wp-content/uploads/e-rate/documents/Forms/479.pdf
 - Form 479s are <u>not</u> submitted to USAC
 - Consortia leads must retain these for 11 years
 - Submit to USAC during audits, if requested

Finding the Form 486 in EPC


After the FCDL has been received, you may file the Form 486. From your EPC Landing Page, click on FCC Form 486 in upper right corner.

Selecting FRNs: Don't User Filter


Note: You do NOT need to use the Filter; the FRNs that Next: Simply select "Add all FRNs" have been funded for FY 2024 will display at the bottom of (only funded FRNs will appear) the screen. The Filter is only helpful if you have a long list of FRNs and need to search for a single one. If all data is accurate, simply click **Continue**. (If you need to change the Service Start Date to a date LATER than what you listed on the 471, check the box next to the FRN # and enter the revised date. Note: This is extremely rare and if you do it for a C1 FRN, USAC will reduce your funding if you push back your service start date.)

Early Filing/CIPA Waiver?

Early Filing: Only check this box if the FCDL is dated prior to July 31 and if your services will begin prior to July. Don't check after July 31.

<u>CIPA Waiver</u>: Do not check.

(Virtually all entities are CIPA compliant and therefore <u>do</u> <u>not</u> check the CIPA waiver box.)

Click Continue

(The only time you should ever use "Send for Certification" is if you want someone else in your EPC profile to certify the application.)

Early Filing

CIPA Certifications – All Applicants Except Consortia

Be Careful – don't get click happy!!!

ONLY check the first circle to signify that you are CIPA compliant.

Do NOT check the 2nd or 3rd buttons!

(Rare: If you are NOT CIPA compliant and are only receiving telecommunications services (not Internet or C2), then check the 3^{rd} box

CIPA Certifications – Consortia Only

Tricky!!!! Consortia have different CIPA certifications:

CIPA Certifications

- tify as the Billed Entity for the consortium that I have collected duly completed and signed FCC Forms 479 from all eligible members of the consortium.
- pertify as the Billed Entity for the consortium that the only services that have been approved for discounts under the universal service support mechanism on behalf of eligible members of the consortium are telecommunications services, and therefore the requirements of the Children's Internet Protection Act, as codified at 47 U.S.C. § 254(h) and (l), do not apply.

Waiver Clarification *

- tify that some or all of the eligible consortium members checked FCC Form 479 Item 6d to seek a CIPA Waiver, and request from the Administrator I can provide this information.
- o lentify that no eligible consortium members checked FCC Form 479 Item 6d to seek a CIPA Waiver.


